1. Damage Assessment Reporting Drill August 5, 2021

On August 5, 2021, Valley Water's Office of Emergency Services conducted a Damage Assessment Reporting Drill for Valley Water. The purpose of the drill was to provide an opportunity for Valley Water to practice earthquake response assessment protocols and procedures, while testing the use of the California Common Operating Picture (CalCOP) application as Valley Water's damage assessment reporting tool. CalCOP is a Geographical Information System (GIS)-based platform used by first responder agencies to share situation status information during emergencies. The CalCOP system is run by the State of California and made available to Valley Water via the Bay Area Urban Area Security Initiative.

The Drill included 40 participants, which resulted in 30 field incident reports being submitted to Valley Water's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) via the CalCOP application. These reports included facilities such as the Penitencia and Santa Teresa Water Treatment Plants, the Advanced Water Purification Center, multiple dams and reservoirs, as well multiple administrative facilities. Each incident report was uploaded through a mobile phone application, plotted on the GIS interface, and included picture(s) and/or video. The situational awareness provided by these field reports is invaluable during the early stages of an emergency and informs Valley Water leadership decisions and priorities from the EOC.

Drill participants included Post Earthquake Dam Assessment Program (PEDAP) volunteers, and staff from Valley Water's Dam Safety, Facilities, Information Technology, Water Treatment Plants, Security, Raw Water Field Operations and Pipeline Maintenance, as well as Office of Emergency

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Services. Although the participants are from a diverse range of business units with different damage assessment responsibilities, this drill demonstrated that Valley Water is able to work together to assess damage and share status information on a common platform.

As a result of this Drill, multiple Valley Water business groups identified areas for assessment process improvements. The Drill also demonstrated that CalCOP is an efficient GIS-based reporting tool that is user-friendly and allows for the EOC to gather real-time assessment information from the field. Additional CalCOP trainings and damage assessment drills will be scheduled moving forward to continue to build Valley Water emergency response capabilities.

2. Operations of Emergency Generators

On July 30, 2021, Governor Newsom signed a Proclamation of a State of Emergency related to "extreme heat events." Within the proclamation the following is stated, "...wildfires, drought, and extreme heat events are likely to persist through this summer and recur next summer, and impact several western states simultaneously, posing further threats to California's energy supply and limiting our ability to import additional energy into the State." Further in the declaration the Governor states that the use of stationary generators shall be deemed "emergency use" from a regulatory perspective.

Statewide regulations, issued via the California Air Resource Board, limit the number of hours an emergency generator unit can operate for reliability/maintenance activities but allows unlimited use during an emergency. If the California Independent System Operator issues a grid warning, Valley Water may operate our emergency generator units up to two hours prior to the grid warning and for one hour after the grid warning ends. Such generator run times should be recorded in the generator log(s) as "emergency use" and will not count against permitted hours of operation specified for each permitted emergency generator unit. The Governor's proclamation will remain in effect through October 31, 2021.

3. Safe, Clean Water Grant Closeout: Grassroots Ecology's Westwind Barn Stormwater Infiltration Project.

In Fiscal Year 2018, Valley Water awarded Grassroots Ecology (Grantee) a \$70,605.60 Safe, Clean Water Program B3 Grant for their Westwind Barn Stormwater Infiltration Project (Project). Grassroots Ecology completed the Project on June 30, 2021 and submitted the final invoice items on August 9, 2021, allowing for grant closeout.

The grant funded environmental stewardship activities to increase stormwater infiltration at the Westwind Community Barn in the upper Adobe Creek Watershed in Los Altos Hills, California. The Grantee engaged 628 volunteers to install a series of berms and contour plantings to slow and treat surface runoff to safeguard Moody Creek from polluted runoff. Major grant activities included native plant installation and maintenance, invasive plant removal and regenerating riparian habitats downstream of the barn. The Project also provided the opportunity for the Grantee to engage with volunteers to grow, plant and care for native plants.

Key Outcomes:

Established two berms that resulted in increased runoff filtration, sediment deposition and

- reduced erosion.
- Installed more than 1,950 native plants and planted 36 native plant species to enhance the riparian corridor.
- Engaged 628 community members to clear invasive plants and install native plants.
- Conducted 12 photo-monitoring surveys to monitor the Project activities.

4. South San Francisco Bay Shoreline Project – Phase I, Reaches 1-3 Construction Contract Award

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) has awarded a construction contract for the South San Francisco Bay Shoreline Project (Project) Phase I, Reaches 1-3, in the amount of \$129,801,500 to Maloney Odin Joint Venture of Novato, California on August 9, 2021. This Project is a partnership with the USACE, Valley Water, and the California State Coastal Conservancy and will provide for coastal storm risk management, ecosystem restoration, and recreational opportunities. The Project will also include protection for sea level rise. The federal share of the awarded contract amount is \$71,390,825 and the non-federal share is \$58,410,675. Valley Water's share will be paid for by Watershed Stream Stewardship funds with partial reimbursement from the San Francisco Bay Restoration Authority Measure AA grant and the Department of Water Resources State Subventions Program. The USACE will be responsible for construction management. Construction of Reaches 1-3 will occur over the next three years.

5. Valley Water hosts virtual public meeting on potential updates to the Groundwater Management Plan.

On August 12, 2021, Valley Water hosted a virtual public meeting to inform the community on the potential updates to the Groundwater Management Plan.

Valley Water Board of Directors Chair Estremera provided opening remarks during the meeting to the 45 participants joining via Zoom and Facebook Live. Valley Water Vice Chair Kremen and Directors Hsueh, Santos and Varela were also in attendance. During the presentation, Valley Water provided background on its activities related to groundwater and how updates to the Groundwater Management Plan are required every five years by the State's Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA). Following the presentation, Valley Water responded to questions related to the plan, current and future groundwater management activities, and how the drought impacts the county's groundwater supply.

July 2021

In accordance with the Santa Clara Valley Water District Board (Valley Water) Investment policy, staff provides a detailed investment report to the Board of Directors on a quarterly basis. In addition to the quarterly investment report, Government Code section 53607 requires the Treasurer of the local agency who has been delegated with the authority to invest funds to provide a monthly report of the investment transactions to the legislative body. This report is provided to the Board in compliance with Government Code section 53607 and Executive Limitation-4 Financial Management.

Attached is the report of investments for the month of July 2021. All investments were in compliance with the Investment Policy and performed on par with Valley Water's benchmark yield. The attached report includes a summary of the portfolio holdings, details of each security in the portfolio and an investment activity summary with comparisons to the previous 12 months. The following are highlights of the investment activities for the month:

- The book value of Valley Water's portfolio as of July 31, 2021 was \$658.2 million. This represents a decrease of approximately \$108 million compared to the book value as of June 30, 2021. The decrease in book value is primarily due to various planned expenditures in July, such as the capital expenditures for the San Francisco Bay Shoreline project (\$46 million), semi-annual payments for the State Water Project and Central Valley Project (\$13.2 million), as well as annual payments to the California Public Employees' Retirement System (\$24.8 million), and other monthly expenditures.
- Valley Water's portfolio is invested with a primary goal of safety. To accomplish this goal, we only invest in securities that are permitted by California Government Code and the Board Investment Policy. These securities have high credit ratings and maturities of no more than 5 years. As of July 31, 2021, approximately 65% of the portfolio was held in US Government Treasury/Agency/Municipal Bonds, 30% was held in liquid funds (Local Area Investment Fund, money market mutual fund, and short-term deposits), and 5% in supranational/corporate medium-term notes.
- The portfolio had a yield-to-maturity of 1.07% for the month of July 2021. This is 0.49% above Valley Water's benchmark, the 24-month floating average of the 2-year Treasury note, which was 0.58%. The portfolio yield is expected to continue to decline due to the overall lower interest rate environment.
- Valley Water's portfolio is reviewed every month for compliance with the Investment Policy. All investments were in compliance for the reporting period.
- California Government Code requires that a public entity structure its portfolio so that it, at
 minimum, can meet expenditures for the next six months. The investment portfolio has been
 structured to ensure that sufficient monies will be available to cover anticipated expenditures in
 the coming six months.
